



## **Dress Code**

It is expected that members will choose to dress in a fashion befitting the surrounding and atmosphere provided in the setting of the Club. It is also expected that members will advise their guests of the dress requirements. The Club may publish dress requirements from time to time, which may differ among the various Club Facilities.

**Men:** Shirts with collars and sleeves, slacks or Bermuda shorts of no more than 2 inches above the knee are considered appropriate attire. Tank tops, tee shirts, mesh shirts, sweat pants, warm-up suits not intended for golfers, blue jeans, work jeans, swim wear, short shorts, cut-offs, gym shorts, tennis outfits or other athletic shorts are not permitted.

**Women:** Dresses, skirts, slacks, mid-length shorts and blouses are considered appropriate attire. Halter tops, tee shirts, cut-offs, sweat pants, warm-up suits not intended for golfers, blue jeans, swim wear, tennis dresses, short shorts, or other athletic shorts are not permitted.

**Shoes:** Appropriate golf shoes are required for all golfers. Football, soccer or other large knobby spike shoes are not allowed. Tennis shoes or other soft sole shoes are subject to the approval of the Golf Professional on duty. Use of non-metal spikes of a type approved by the Club is mandatory.

This dress code is mandatory for all players. Improperly dressed golfers shall be asked to change before playing. If you are in doubt concerning your attire, please check with the golf shop personnel before starting play.

Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times when on Club Facilities other than at the locker room facilities.

## **Walking Policy**

Walking is permitted anytime Monday-Friday and after 10 AM on Saturday, Sunday & Holidays.

## Golf Cart Policy

- A member or guest on the Club facilities without proper assignment and registration in the golf shop shall not use golf carts.
- Golf carts may only be used on the golf course when the course is open for play.
- Golf carts may only be operated by persons at least 16 years of age having a valid automobile driver's license.
- Only two persons and two sets of golf clubs are permitted per golf cart.
- Persons riding in a golf cart who are not playing golf will be required to pay a fee.
- Privately owned golf carts are not permitted.
- Pull carts are not permitted.
- Obey all golf cart traffic signs.
- Always use golf cart paths around tees and greens where provided.
- Be careful to avoid soft areas on fairways, especially after rains. Use roughs whenever possible.
- Operation of a golf cart is at the risk of the operator. Persons who are or appear to be legally intoxicated may not operate a golf cart. Cost of repair to a golf cart which is damaged by the member, a family member or guest of the member shall be charged to the member.
- Each member accepts and assumes all responsibility for liability connected with operation of the golf cart. The member also expressly indemnifies and agrees to hold harmless the Indemnified Parties from any and all damages, whether direct or consequential, arising from or related to the member's, his or her family members' or guests' use and operation of the golf cart.
- "Course Closed" or "Hole Closed" signs are to be adhered to without exception.
- Violations of the golf cart rules may result in loss of golf cart privileges and/or playing privileges.

## Speed of Play Policy

It is the goal of all players to complete their round in less than four and a half hours. This amount of time is more than adequate, provided all players remain aware of the rights of others to play without delay. It is the responsibility of each group to keep pace with the group ahead. If a group falls one complete hole behind the group ahead, the group should allow the following group to go through. It is each group's responsibility to be observant of its position on the course and keep pace. The ranger has the authority to keep play moving at the proper pace for all players' enjoyment. Players unable to keep proper pace may be requested to leave the course.

If a player is repeatedly warned for slow play, the Club may take such action as it deems appropriate, including without limitation, restricting the person's use of the golf courses during certain times of the day.

## **Guest Check-In Policy**

- All Guests must register with the golf shop before beginning play.
- The Club reserves the right to require identification from each guest.

## **Cell Phone Policy**

Cell phones are restricted in the dining room.

All cell phones should be on “silent” when on the golf course. While cell phone use is discouraged, be courteous to other golfers around you if the need to take a call should arise.

## **Driving Range Access**

- The practice range is open during normal operating hours as posted in the golf shop. The practice range may be closed for general maintenance, weather conditions and clinics at the Club’s discretion.
- Range balls are for use on the practice range and may not be used on the golf course.
- Golf carts are not permitted on any tee area. Parking of golf carts is allowed in designated areas.
- Balls must be hit from designated areas. No hitting is permitted from the rough or sides of the practice range.
- Proper golf attire is required at all times on the practice range.
- Handbag ball shaggers are not permitted.
- Lessons by unauthorized professionals are prohibited.

## **Directions**

### ***Directions from Philadelphia***

1. Take Route 42 South to the Camden County College (2nd Blackwood/Pine Hill, Route 534) exit, approximately 7.5 miles from the Walt Whitman Bridge.
2. Bear right on exit ramp onto Blackwood/Clementon Road (Route 534 East).
3. Take Blackwood/Clementon Road for approximately 2.6 miles (9 traffic lights) to Branch Avenue.
4. Make a right turn onto Branch Avenue; take for approximately .75 of a mile to Pine Hill Golf Club entrance on the right.
5. Make a right turn and follow entrance road to the top of the hill, the Clubhouse is to the right.

### ***Directions from Route 73 North & South***

1. Take Route 73 North or South to the Berlin Circle.
2. Take the circle to Milford Road (in between Blockbuster and Palace Diner); make a right turn onto Milford Road. Milford Road turns into Berlin/Cross Keys Road.
3. Take Berlin/Cross keys Road for approximately 2 miles (Over railroad tracks and through Route 30/White Horse Pike) to Hickstown Road (Route 688).
4. Make a right turn onto Hickstown Road.
5. Take Hickstown Road for approximately 1.5 miles (1 traffic light) to West Branch Ave.
6. Make a right turn onto Branch Avenue.
7. Take Branch Avenue for 1.5 miles (past 1 traffic light) to Pine Hill Golf Club entrance on the left.
8. Make a left turn and follow entrance road to the top of the hill; the Clubhouse is to the right.

### ***Directions from New Jersey Turnpike***

1. Take New Jersey Turnpike to exit 3.
2. Bear left through the tollbooths towards Route 168 South (Woodbury/Atlantic City).
3. Take Route 168 South (Black Horse Pike) for approximately 4.1 miles to Church Street.
4. Make a left turn onto Church Street (cemetery on left corner and Mobil Gas Station on right corner). Church Street turns into Blackwood/Clementon Road after the first light.
5. Take Blackwood/Clementon Road for 3.2 miles to Branch Avenue.
6. Make a right turn onto Branch Avenue
7. Take Branch Avenue for approximately .7 of a mile to Pine Hill Golf Club entrance on the right.
8. Make a right turn and follow entrance road to the top of the hill; the Clubhouse is to the right.

### ***Directions From Atlantic City***

1. Take Atlantic City Expressway to exit 41.
2. Bear right on exit ramp to the 1st traffic light and make a right turn onto Berlin/Cross Keys Road.
3. Take Berlin/Cross Keys Road for 1.8 miles to Erial Road (3 traffic lights).
4. Continue on Berlin/Cross Keys Road for another .4 of a mile to Kearsley Road (just past the Oak Grove Gun Club).
5. Make a left onto Kearsley Road.
6. Take Kearsley Road/Branch Avenue for 3 miles (past 2 lights) to Pine Hill Golf Club entrance on the left.
7. Make a left turn and follow entrance road to the top of the hill; the Clubhouse is to the right.
